Auditory/Oral School of New York StriVright to Succeed comprises both a center- and home-based Early Intervention infant/toddler program for children between the ages of birth and three years and a center-based preschool for students between the ages of three and five years. The educational and clinical philosophy is based upon the auditory/oral methodology of teaching and habilitating students with hearing loss. Our teachers and therapeutic staff, including speech-language pathologists, occupational and physical therapists, counselors, audiologists, literacy specialist, and music therapist, are committed to facilitating their students' ability to understand spoken language, use oral language, become independent communicators, and effective social interactants. In addition to providing educational and therapeutic services, *AOSNY/StriVright* provides multidisciplinary diagnostic evaluations that assess a child's functioning in one or more developmental areas including communication, fine and gross motor, cognitive, social/emotional, audiological, and sensory skill development. Depending upon the needs and preferences of each family, diagnostic and/or therapeutic sessions can be conducted at either our center or in the child's home.

In addition to center-based educational and therapeutic services, *AOSNY/StriVright to Succeed* provides itinerant services in local schools for those students who are able to learn in a mainstream setting but require educational support such as speech and language therapy or HES (Hearing Education Services). The members of the *Auditory/Oral School of New York/StriVright to Succeed* team are truly committed to meeting the needs of *all* of their students and families, as ensuring the provision of best quality services and maintenance of the best practices model is paramount.
